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## About the MRC

*The Jefferson Marine Resources Committee is an advisory group to the Board of County Commissioners and part of the regional Northwest Straits Marine Conservation Initiative. Members are citizen volunteers committed to protecting and restoring our local marine habitats.*

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## **Jefferson MRC – Voting Protocol for MRC Meetings (Following OPMA, led by Chair)**

1. Public comment prior to discussion (new rule as of 2022)
2. MRC Discussion
  - Name open positions and address any questions on roles/responsibilities
  - Call for nominations from the floor
    - Members can nominate either themselves or other members
  - Call for a motion to approve the slate of nominations (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>)
  - If seconded, call for a vote using one of the methods described below
  - If not seconded, resume discussion until ready for a second call for a motion
3. MRC Vote on slate of nominations
  - a. By Ballot
    - i. (2) individuals must be designated to count paper ballots
    - ii. Paper ballots will be distributed to all voting members
    - iii. Voting members write their name on their ballot
    - iv. Voting members write in their choice for each open position
    - v. Voting members fold papers in half and hand to a ballot counter
    - vi. After all voting members have voted, a break is called, and ballots are counted in an open area accessible to all members/the public
      1. Anyone may ask to see the ballots/tallies at any time
    - vii. After both ballot counters have finished and their results are in agreement, results are handed to Chair
    - viii. Chair resumes meeting, and shares winning nominations for all positions
    - ix. Paper ballots and tally sheets are given to Coordinator to record dissent in the minutes and for record keeping
  - b. By Consensus
    - i. Raised hands for all in favor/opposed, dissent recorded in Minutes
    - ii. By voice for all in favor/opposed, dissent recorded in Minutes
  - c. For all votes:
    - Silence gives consent in any vote; a dissenting vote must be clearly demonstrated
    - A majority of members decides a motion if consensus cannot be reached (MRC Bylaws 7.1)

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### **MRC Bylaws on election of officers:**

**Vote: Remove Robert's Rules of Order and Secret Ballot from MRC Bylaws, Page 1**

**Why do we need to remove these?**

- Robert's Rules of Order: The MRC does not strictly follow Robert's Rules of Order during MRC meetings
- Secret Ballot: Voting by "secret ballot," aka a ballot vote held in secret/without public witness, is against the rules of the OPMA (MRC Bylaws 5.5)

**Replacement language for bylaws:**

**Vote: Remove Robert's Rules of Order and Secret Ballot from MRC Bylaws, Page 2****Two separate motions need to be made:**

- 1) I move to send a recommendation to the BOCC that the MRC amend its bylaws to remove Robert's Rules of Order as the committee's binding parliamentary authority. Robert's Rules may still be consulted as a general reference to support orderly and fair meetings, but the committee shall not be obligated to follow them strictly.

and

- 2) I move to send a recommendation to the BOCC that the MRC amend its bylaws to remove the 'secret ballot' voting procedure for electing MRC officers, and replace it with an 'open ballot' voting procedure.

**MRC Bylaws Quorum – Voting procedure****7. Quorum - Voting**

- 7.1. The decision-making approach of the MRC will be by consensus. If consensus cannot be reached, the MRC will recognize a simple majority vote. Any dissenting opinions will be recorded and included in the meeting summary.
- 7.2. A simple majority of the total of the voting members currently appointed to the MRC constitutes a quorum for the conduct of MRC business. If all positions are filled then a quorum shall be 7 members. Voting is by voice vote, except where specified differently in these rules. Alternatively, the MRC itself may require a ballot or roll call vote. In lieu of an absent member, a member's designated alternate, if present, will be included in the quorum tally.
